Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to thank all parents for the maturity of Year 11 over the last half-term and remind them of our offer of remote provision for the next 2 weeks that will give students an opportunity to ready themselves for their next steps whether that be B&F College, Sixth Form College, an apprenticeship or employment.

Firstly, I would like to say how fantastic Year 11 were on the last few days of last half-term. There was a lot of emotion on the last day and in the Leavers' Assembly. This was understandable given what they and our staff have worked through in the last 15 months. I have to say they were a credit to you, the school and most importantly themselves. We wish them all the best and hope as many of them as possible take advantage of the Year 11 Transition programme being offered to them in the next few weeks.

As part of our duty of care, we are still legally responsible to safeguard your child before their official leaving date of Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June. This means we will need to actually see and speak to them twice before that date, with a gap no longer than 10 days starting from Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June. This can be done remotely if we see them on camera. We are going to achieve this in a variety of ways.

- Tutor GMeets
- Attendance to the GMeets organised as part of the Year 11 Transition Programme
- Book/Resources/Uniform donation drop-ins days at school
- Home visits

Students that attend the organised GMeets as part of the Year 11 Transition Programme will be marked as seen if they have their cameras on at the end of the session.

In addition to this Miss Sharpe will be available for drop ins over the next two weeks. This will be an opportunity for our students to come in for a cake and a catch up. We also ask that students bring in any text books they have yet to return and if possible we ask that students bring in any old uniform they no longer need. This includes blazers, skirts and PE kits. This will support our families at Montgomery who may be struggling.

Also available at these drop ins will be a food collection point, if you need anything at all please drop in to collect or ask your child to collect at the drop ins.

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If students are passing our main school reception at any point during the school day, please ask them to drop in and say hi to us.

If you do not live locally we have also scheduled tutor GMeets. Students will be sent a link to their school email address to access the GMeet but students just need to sign in to the meeting and let their tutor know how they are getting on. We will also send text reminder to parents with the GMeets links the day before, which can be forwarded to students.
