Once you receive your GCSE (and other qualification) results from your school on Thursday 12th August, upload these on to our enrolment portal and confirm your course choices. If you need a discussion of your study programme, we will arrange this with you as soon as possible. Otherwise, you will be

automatically enrolled and we will call you before the term starts to check everything is OK.

Induction Days

You're all set to start college. You will be invited to one of our induction days, held on 7th–10th September. On this day you will meet your Pastoral Mentor who will guide you through a programme of activities to help you settle into college.
